Our work environment is professional, dynamic, innovative, and compassionate. FSG is fully integrated into the tight-knit community of Glencoe, which provides unique opportunities to engage in prevention, collaboration, and service delivery for clients and the community at large.

The Staff Therapist will have the opportunity to work with children, youth, adults, couples, and families to address challenging social and emotional issues. Position-specific responsibilities include:

- Provide individual, couples, and/or family therapy utilizing an accepted clinical framework.
- Complete intake assessments, treatment plans, progress notes, and discharge summaries using our electronic medical record system.
- Provide client casework services to address clinical social service needs.
- Provides crisis intervention services in partnership with Glencoe Public Safety.
- Work collaboratively with a range of community partners and FSG colleagues to plan and deliver education programs and events.
- Assess client risk of harm, provides appropriate safety planning, and completes required reporting.
- Adhere to professional standards of practice regarding clinical care and confidentiality.

The Staff Therapist must be able to interact in a supportive and professional manner with clients, staff, board members and community with the ability to respond effectively in crisis situations. The person in this position must work well in a small office team environment and be open to change as Family Service of Glencoe continues to grow. FSG's staff therapists have the opportunity to grow their careers by supervising/mentoring MA students, developing groups and community outreach/prevention programs, and/or pursuing clinical specialties. FSG is currently working in a hybrid model and applicant should have comfort with providing telehealth services.

Qualifications: The successful candidate will possess:

- ✓ Illinois full clinical licensure (preferred)
